CONE CU debit card restricted

To protect members from losing personal financial information and to protect your credit union from fraud, CONE Credit Union will now restrict debit card use in certain situations.

Members will no longer be able to use debit cards for international transactions -- whether online or in person in a foreign country.

Members can use CONE CU debit cards at ATMs in foreign countries. Please take precautions and be on guard against theft in those situations. Some foreign ATM transactions can incur fees. Please check before leaving on your foreign trip.

In addition, debit cards can not be used domestically if the card number is punched in -- and not swiped.
